To apply for certification, a person must be able to demonstrate the required operating experience and educational requirements defined below.

Grade I: High school diploma, general educational development certificate or equivalent and 50 contact hours of wastewater related education; and one year full-time experience as a industrial waste inspector.

Grade II: Requirements for Grade I and an additional 50 contact hours of wastewater related education (total of 100 contact hours); and two total years of full-time experience as an industrial waste inspector.

Grade III: Requirements for Grade II and two postsecondary courses of instruction; and three years full-time experience as an industrial waste inspector.

Grade IV: Requirements for Grade III and two additional postsecondary courses of instruction (total of four postsecondary); and at least four years full-time experience as an industrial waste inspector.

WASTEWATER PROFESSIONAL CODE OF CONDUCT

The Wastewater Professional Code of Conduct requires certificants holding Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator, Water quality analyst, Industrial Waste Operator, Industrial Waste Inspector, Plant Maintenance Technologist and Wastewater Quality Analyst certifications to act honestly, competently, and with integrity and to use their knowledge and skill for protection of the environment. As a condition of holding and maintaining a Nevada certification, I agree to:
